

Subject Municipalities prohibited from entering into certain nondisclosure agreements

Summary

This bill prohibits municipalities, which includes a variety of political subdivisions with authority to enter into a contract for the use of real property, and any person acting in their capacity as a representative of the municipality, from entering into a nondisclosure agreement or other contract with a private person restricting the municipality from disclosing information to members of the public about the development of land, an economic development project or program, or a project or program financed in whole or in part with the municipality's tax revenues, financial obligations, or taxing powers, except as required by state or federal law.

Void and unenforceable provisions may be severed from other provisions in the contract. Requires a municipality to publicly disclose any nondisclosure agreement or similar contract that it has entered into.

Effective the day following final enactment.
