2.1 The sums shown in the column under "Appropriations" are added to the appropriations  
2.2 in Laws 2017, chapter 95, article 1, to the agencies and for the purposes specified in this  
2.3 article. The appropriations are from the general fund, or another named fund, and are  
2.4 available for the fiscal years indicated for each purpose. The figures "2018" and "2019"  
2.5 used in this article mean that the addition to the appropriation listed under them is available

372.22 commissioner of corrections to fund the offender health care contract. \$1,968,000 is added  
372.23 to the base in fiscal year 2020 and \$3,168,000 is added to the base in fiscal years 2021,  
372.24 2022, and 2023. In fiscal year 2024 and beyond, \$0 is added to the base.

372.16 Sec. 23. **TRANSFER.**
