As of Friday, February 8, 2019, the following bills are hereby referred to the **Early Childhood Finance and Policy Division.** 

HF770 (Franson) Relating to human services; modifying day care initial licensure requirement; directing commissioner of human services to implement a child care provider communication process, develop plain-language handbook, and develop a uniform family day care provider application; modifying child care tax credits.

HF791 (Franson) Relating to human services; establishing criminal penalties for failing to cooperate in child care assistance program fraud investigations.
