

1.1 moves to amend H. F. No. 3, in conference committee, as follows:

1.2 On R22, House language, (H0003-4)

1.3 Page 21, delete subdivision 4 and insert:

1.4 "Subd. 4. **Early renewal and expiration date extension.** (a) For purposes of this
1.5 subdivision, "federal full compliance date" means the date when full compliance with the
1.6 REAL ID Act is federally required and no extensions are in effect for federal acceptance
1.7 of Minnesota-issued licenses and identification cards for official purposes, as most recently
1.8 specified by the United States Department of Homeland Security under Code of Federal
1.9 Regulations, title 6, part 37.

1.10 (b) For purposes of this subdivision, "eligible applicant" means an applicant for a REAL
1.11 ID-compliant driver's license or identification card who:

1.12 (1) holds a valid Minnesota driver's license or Minnesota identification card that:

1.13 (i) was issued prior to the date Minnesota commenced issuing REAL ID-compliant
1.14 licenses and Minnesota identification cards; and

1.15 (ii) either (A) has an expiration date that is after the federal full compliance date; or (B)
1.16 does not have an expiration date as provided under Minnesota Statutes, section 171.07,
1.17 subdivision 4;

1.18 (2) submits the license or identification card application no later than one year following
1.19 the federal full compliance date; and

1.20 (3) is otherwise eligible to obtain the license or identification card under Minnesota
1.21 Statutes, chapter 171.

1.22 (c) For the first instance of issuing a REAL ID-compliant driver's license, the expiration
1.23 date is the birthday of the applicant in the fourth year following the date that the driver's

2.1 license would otherwise expire absent this subdivision, notwithstanding the requirements
2.2 of Minnesota Statutes, section 171.27, paragraph (a).

2.3 (d) For the first instance of issuing a REAL ID-compliant identification card, the
2.4 expiration date is the birthday of the applicant in the fourth year following the date that the
2.5 identification card would otherwise expire absent this subdivision, notwithstanding the
2.6 requirements of Minnesota Statutes, section 171.07, subdivision 4, paragraph (a).

2.7 (e) A surcharge is imposed for early renewal under this subdivision. The surcharge is
2.8 in addition to the fees and surcharges under Minnesota Statutes, sections 171.06, subdivision
2.9 2; 171.061, subdivision 4; and 171.07, subdivisions 3 and 3a; or other law. The surcharge
2.10 is calculated based on the length of time otherwise remaining absent this subdivision until
2.11 expiration of the driver's license or identification card, as follows:

2.12 (1) \$2 for a current expiration date of no more than 17 months from the date of application
2.13 under this subdivision;

2.14 (2) \$4 for a current expiration date of 18 months to no more than 29 months; and

2.15 (3) \$6 for a current expiration date of more than 29 months.

2.16 (f) This subdivision does not apply to:

2.17 (1) issuance of a new driver's license or Minnesota identification card;

2.18 (2) issuance or renewal of a noncompliant license or identification card, as defined in
2.19 Minnesota Statutes, section 171.01, subdivision 41a;

2.20 (3) issuance or renewal of an enhanced driver's license or enhanced identification card;

2.21 (4) reinstatement of a canceled, suspended, or revoked license;

2.22 (5) a driver's license subject to expiration under Minnesota Statutes, section 171.27,
2.23 paragraphs (b) to (d); and

2.24 (6) a Minnesota identification card subject to expiration under Minnesota Statutes, section
2.25 171.07, subdivision 4, paragraphs (b) to (e)."
