Summary

This section allows counties to accept electronic filings, or mailed or faxed marriage applications and to examine the parties under oath using audio or video. This section requires counties to follow all the provisions of existing statute but does not require one of the parties to appear in person for the application. This section only allows this exception when a peacetime emergency related to COVID-19 is in place and expires on January 15, 2021.
