## **Bill Description**

This bill proposes extending the 31-day temporary permit to 60 days for vehicles purchased in Minnesota for the purpose of being removed from state.

#### **Assumptions**

DVS estimates minimal programming costs that would be covered under the existing vendor contract.

Changes made in MNDrive will be effective for temporary permits issued on or after Oct. 1, 2025.

Other requirements for vehicles being removed from state such as removing any license plates from the vehicle will still be in effect.

All permits are printed on-demand so there would be no disposal fees for existing 31-day inventory.

DVS staff, dealers and business partners will be notified through email notifications and monthly "Time With Trainer" training sessions offered by DVS. No additional funding will be needed for this.

The public website information will need to be updated. This can be done with existing staff, and no additional appropriations will be needed.
