



- Subject Metropolitan regional parks funding provisions modified

Summary

This bill amends the definition of "implementing agency" for the purposes of the metropolitan area regional parks funding statute to include the city of Fridley, which would make the city eligible for money through the Metropolitan Council to fund operation and maintenance expenditures for regional park and open space systems.

Under current law, the cities of St. Paul and Bloomington are defined as implementing agencies, along with the counties of Anoka, Washington, Ramsey, Scott, Carver, and Dakota; the Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board; and the Three Rivers Park District.

Effective the day following final enactment.
