Overview

This bill repeals the statute that prohibits local ordinances that ban the use of paper, plastic, or reusable bags for packaging of any item or good purchased from a merchant, itinerant vendor, or peddler.

The law became effective May 31, 2017, and invalidated ordinances existing on that date.
