Bill Description

Section 1 requires the commissioner of human services to conduct background studies on MNsure consumer assistance partners

Section 2 requires the commissioner of DHS to recover the cost of the background study through a fee not to exceed \$20 per background study conducted under section1.

Section 3 requires all MNsure consumer assistance partners to have a background study completed by the commissioner of human services in compliance with MS 245C.

Assumptions

- DHS would complete 600 background studies per year on MNsure consumer assistors. This is based on an estimated 25% turnover rate annually for the 2,400 consumer assistors who received initial certification.
- The implementation date of the MNsure consumer assistance partners is January 1, 2106. Because this starts six months into FY16, only 300 studies will be conducted during that fiscal year.
- A DHS background study, on average, costs \$20 in DHS staff time. This is recovered through a fee of \$20.

Expenditure and/or Revenue Formula

Expenditures

600 studies x \$20 DHS costs/study = \$12,000

For FY16: 300 studies x \$20 DHS costs/study = \$6,000

Revenues

600 studies x \$20 Fee/study = \$12,000

Bill Description

The proposal provides DHS authority to conduct background studies on MNsure Consumer Assistance Partners. This proposal is an expansion of DHS current authority to conduct background studies.

Assumptions

This bill as amended codifies existing practice between the Department of Human Services and MNsure related to background checks for Consumer Assistance Partners. It is anticipated that approximately 600 studies would be performed per year based on the previous two years of available data. Because this provision is simply putting in statute existing practice, MNsure would not see any additional expense or savings.
