Children's Residential Facility Funding and IMD Status

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IMD Status and Impact on State/Federal Funding

- > 16-beds = IMD
- IMD = no federal matching funding
 - Exception: < 15 days in a month (managed care only)
- 100% state funding = Program IM

IMD Status and Children's Residential Facilities

- **2001**: Federal matching funding for residential mental health treatment for children on Medical Assistance
 - Counties are responsible for the non-federal share under fee-for-service
- 2014: CMS raises questions about children's residential mental health treatment programs and potential IMD status
- 2018: Minnesota completes review, submits report to CMS
- 2019: 8 IMD in Minnesota a with a total of 363 beds

Children's Residential IMDs and Funding

- Historically, children's residential treatment services excluded from the state law allowing state funding when a person is in an IMD
- In 2017, state law was amended to authorize state funding to pay for the lost federal share for children's residential IMDs. This authority expires on May 1, 2019
- If this authority expires, counties will be responsible for 100 percent of the cost
