1.2 Page 1, line 6, delete "GRANT PROGRAM" and insert "FUNDING"

1.3 Page 1, line 7, delete "Definition" and insert "Definitions"

1.4 Page 1, line 8, before the period, insert "and "school" means a school district, charter
1.5 school, or cooperative unit"

1.6 Page 1, line 9, after "Establishment" insert "; purpose" and delete "grant" and insert
1.7 "funding"

1.8 Page 1, after line 14, insert:

1.9 "Subd. 3. Aid amount. Each school is eligible for onetime distance learning aid equal
1.10 to the lesser of:

1.11 (1) its actual expenditures under subdivision 4; or

1.12 (2) an allowance equal to the amount appropriated in section 3, paragraph (a), divided
1.13 by the statewide enrollment for fiscal year 2019 times the students enrolled in each school
1.14 during fiscal year 2019."

1.15 Renumber the subdivisions in sequence

1.16 Page 1, line 15, delete "A grant awarded" and insert "Aid received" and delete "may"
1.17 and insert "must"

1.18 Page 1, line 19, delete "reimburse a school district or charter school" and insert "pay"

1.19 Page 2, line 1, delete "reimburse a school district or charter school" and insert "pay"

1.20 Page 2, delete subdivisions 4 to 6 and insert:

1.21 "Subd. 5. Schools to report expenditures. Every school that receives aid under this
1.22 section must submit a report to the commissioner of education by February 15, 2021,

2.1 documenting its expenditures and describing the onetime and permanent improvements
2.2 made to its distance learning access delivery system."

2.3 Page 4, after line 19, insert:

2.4 **"EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment."**

2.5 Page 4, line 21, delete "\$8,000,000" and insert "\$15,000,000"

2.6 Page 5, line 20, delete everything after the second period

2.7 Page 5, delete lines 21 and 22

2.8 Page 5, line 23, delete everything after "(d)" and insert "The commissioner of management
2.9 and budget must determine whether any of the expenditures an appropriation is made for
2.10 under this section is an eligible use of federal funding received under the Coronavirus Aid,
2.11 Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, Public Law 116-136, title V. If the
2.12 commissioner of management and budget determines an expenditure is eligible for funding
2.13 under title V of the CARES Act, the amount for the eligible expenditure is appropriated
2.14 from the account where CARES Act money has been deposited and the corresponding
2.15 amount appropriated under this section cancels to the general fund."

2.16 Page 5, delete lines 24 to 26

2.17 Page 5, after line 27, insert:

2.18 "Sec. 4. **APPROPRIATIONS GIVEN EFFECT ONCE.**

2.19 If an appropriation in this act is enacted more than once in the 2020 regular legislative
2.20 session, the appropriations must be given effect only once.

2.21 **EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day after final enactment."**
