

Fiscal Year 2025 Outcomes



PELSB has oversight of teacher licensure standards, licensure renewals, and ethics for approximately 110,000 licensed educators across the state, around 73,000 of whom are actively teaching in Minnesota classroom.

AT A GLANCE, PELSB ANNUALLY:

- Issues around 14,300 new licenses
- Renews approximately 23,000 licenses
- Grants nearly 6,000 special permissions
- Provides oversight and daily support for 38 teacher preparation program providers
- Conducts reviews of 6-10 Minnesota teacher preparation providers
- Provides ongoing Program Review of nearly 630 licensure area programs
- Reviews around 230 teacher-conduct investigations
- Reviewed 560 applications for ethics concerns
