1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. Laws 2023, chapter 37, article 1, section 2, subdivision 18, as amended by
1.4 Laws 2024, chapter 127, article 14, section 9, is amended to read:

1.5 Subd. 18. **Supportive Housing** 10,000,000 -0-

1.6 (a) This appropriation is for the supportive
1.7 housing program under Minnesota Statutes,
1.8 section 462A.42. This is a onetime
1.9 appropriation.

1.10 (b) Of this amount, \$9,000,000 is for grants
1.11 to United States Department of Housing and
1.12 Urban Development Continuum of Care
1.13 Program grantees for fiscal year 2024 whose
1.14 contracts have expired or will expire before
1.15 December 31, 2026, and have experienced or
1.16 will experience funding gaps. The agency may
1.17 prioritize awards to grantees based on need.
1.18 Notwithstanding the application provisions
1.19 outlined in Minnesota Statutes, section
1.20 462A.42, subdivision 5, and the procurement
1.21 provisions outlined in Minnesota Statutes,
1.22 section 16C.06, subdivisions 1, 2, and 6, the
1.23 agency may noncompetitively award grants
1.24 to existing and previous federal Continuum
1.25 of Care funding recipients. Notwithstanding

2.1 Minnesota Statutes, section 462A.42,
2.2 subdivision 4, funds may be used as
2.3 supplemental emergency support resources
2.4 for permanent supportive housing, rapid
2.5 rehousing, transitional housing, and
2.6 system-related activities for the identified
2.7 grantees. The agency will coordinate with
2.8 stakeholders on a distribution process and
2.9 establish such a process within 30 days of
2.10 enactment.

2.11 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."
