- FAST Enterprises awarded contract on August 10, 2019

- COVID impact & successful pivot to online, on demand training

- MNDRIVE launched Nov 16, 2020
- ONE system of record for both Driver & Vehicles Services
- First day of operations -21,000 transactions & \$3.2 M in taxes & fee collections
