Bill Description

This bill relates to state government by updating and deleting outdated warrant-related language in various state statutes.

Assumptions

The majority of this bill is updating language regarding state payments to make it reflective of modern business practices. Most state statutes were created when the only way to issue a payment was by a state warrant which is a paper document that functions similar to a check. This proposal will update statutory references to recognize other electronic forms of payment, by changing the word "warrant" to "payment".

There are a few sections that address other topics:

- Section 4 This is the prepayment statute. The proposed change will allow other types of prepayments when advance payment discounts are provided or for costs that are customarily paid for in advance.
- Section 9 Updates a reference to a statute that was previously renumbered. M.S. 7.19 was renumbered as 16A.271.
- Section 13 Clarifies treatment of warrants that are void.
- Section 17 and 18 Clarifies the roles between MMB and agencies for accounting and collecting debts owed to the state.
