## **Overview**

This bill directs the commissioner of children, youth, and families to conduct a statewide evaluation of out-of-school and youth programming available to youth under 22 years old and appropriates an unspecified amount in fiscal year 2026 for the evaluation.

## **Section Description**

Direction to commissioner of children, youth, and families; report on out-of-school and youth programming.

Paragraph (a) directs the commissioner of children, youth, and families to evaluate the statewide availability of out-of-school and youth programming available to youth under 22 years old. Paragraph (b) directs the commissioner to use a community engagement process when conducting the evaluation. Paragraph (c) provides that the commissioner must submit a report on the evaluation findings and finance and policy recommendations for expanding access to quality out-of-school and youth programming to the legislature by February 15, 2026.

2 Appropriation; report on out-of-school and youth programming.

Provides a onetime appropriation in an unspecified amount in fiscal year 2026 to the commissioner of children, youth, and families to conduct an evaluation of out-of-school and youth programming.
