I am happy to write this letter in support of Kognito Suicide Prevention Training. This online training has been used at Princeton High School for the past two years. In the 2016-2017 school year, all certified staff completed this training. Although not required for all certified staff in the 2017-2018 school year, it was required for all teaching faculty new to the High School. Therefore, the first year, we had 100% of certified staff complete the training and this year we have had 100% of new teachers, therefore, 100% of certified staff have completed this training within the last 12 months. We are hoping to continue our partnership with NAMI Minnesota.

As the main contact for this training, I attest to the ease of implementation. We had minor glitches the first year in password. completely expected. What is not always expected is the quick and congenial support I received from NAMI staff as we worked through these. Our experience with NAMI has been very positive.

The training itself is not set up to just click through it. The participant must be present and engaged in the learning in order to proceed through. At our debrief with staff, it was mentioned several times that in some cases, many went back to choose a different option in order to learn a better outcome. The training was well-received and we followed up with discussion at staff training. I strongly recommend this training program.
