

1.1 Senator ..... moves to amend H.F. No. 3, in conference committee, as follows:

1.2 On R10, Senate language, (UEH0003-3)

1.3 Page 9, delete section 10 and insert:

1.4 "Sec. 10. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 171.06, is amended by adding a subdivision  
1.5 to read:

1.6 Subd. 3b. **Information for applicants.** (a) The commissioner must develop summary  
1.7 information on identity document options. The summary information must be available on  
1.8 the department's Web site and in writing at every location where a person may apply for an  
1.9 enhanced, REAL ID compliant, or noncompliant driver's license or identification card. The  
1.10 summary information must, at a minimum, include:

1.11 (1) each available type of driver's license and Minnesota identification card, including  
1.12 a noncompliant license or identification card, an enhanced driver's license, and an enhanced  
1.13 identification card;

1.14 (2) the official purposes of and limitations on use for each type of driver's license and  
1.15 Minnesota identification card; and

1.16 (3) an overview of data shared outside the state, including through electronic validation  
1.17 or verification systems, as part of the application and issuance of each type.

1.18 (b) The commissioner must ensure that the summary information is available to driver's  
1.19 license and identification card applicants. Renewal notifications mailed to license and  
1.20 identification cardholders must include the Web site address that includes the summary  
1.21 information.

1.22 (c) An applicant for an enhanced or noncompliant license or identification card must  
1.23 sign an acknowledgment that the applicant understands the limitations on use of the license  
1.24 or card."
