"ARTICLE 6

GENERAL PROVISIONS; ALL LEGACY FUNDS

Section 1. [15.431] COMPLIANCE WITH CONSTITUTIONAL REQUIREMENT FOR LEGACY FUNDS.

To ensure compliance with the requirement in Minnesota Constitution, article XI, section 15, that money dedicated under that section must supplement traditional sources of funding and may not be used as a substitute, the legislature shall not appropriate money nor shall an agency grant money to an individual or entity requesting money from the outdoor heritage fund, clean water fund, parks and trails fund, or arts and cultural heritage fund, without written assurance from the individual or entity that the individual or entity will not use the money to fund expenses for a purpose that the individual or entity previously funded with a traditional source of funding. For the purposes of this section, a "traditional source of funding" is a source other than the outdoor heritage fund, clean water fund, parks and trails fund, or arts and cultural heritage fund the individual or entity used three out of the past five years to pay for expenses related to the same purpose for which the individual or entity has proposed to use money from the outdoor heritage fund, clean water fund, parks and trails fund, or arts and cultural heritage fund."
