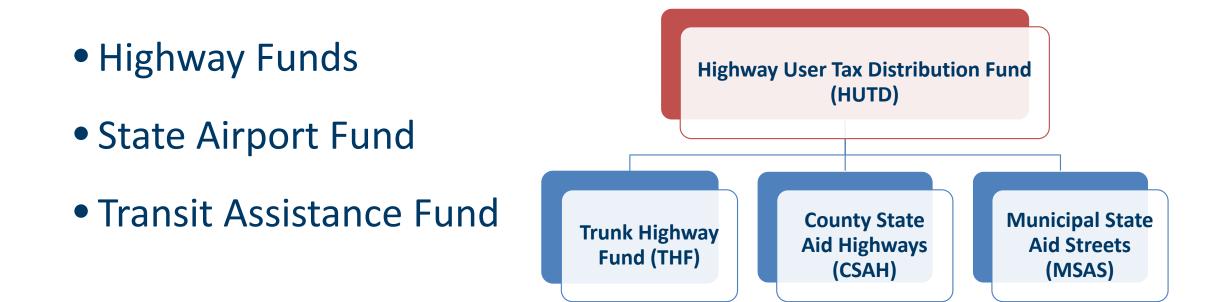

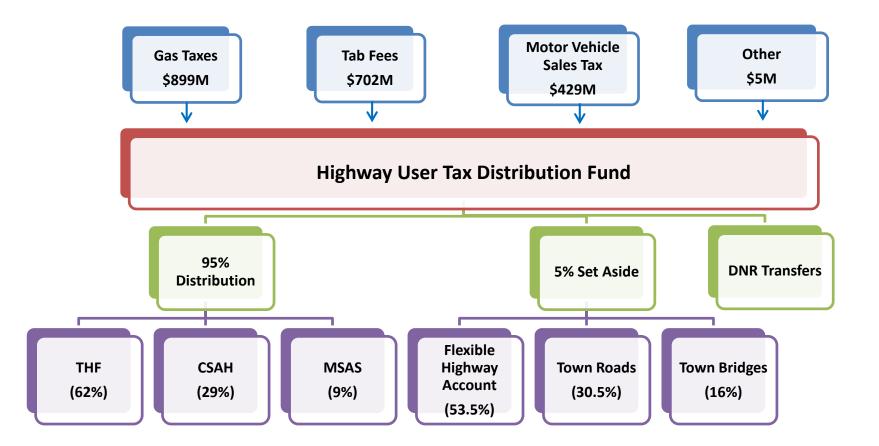

### **HUTD Forecast**

- FY 2016-17 HUTD revenues are down \$45 million (1.1%) compared to the 2016 EOS Forecast. The primary changes are:
  - Gas taxes are up \$6 million (0.3%)
  - Tab fees are down \$32 million (-2.2%)
  - MVST are down \$16 million (-1.8%)
- However, revenue continues to increase year-over-year

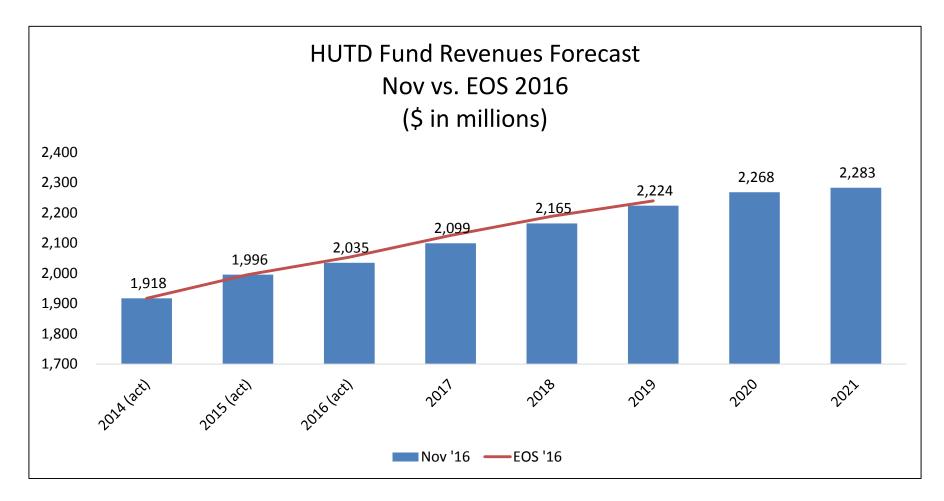

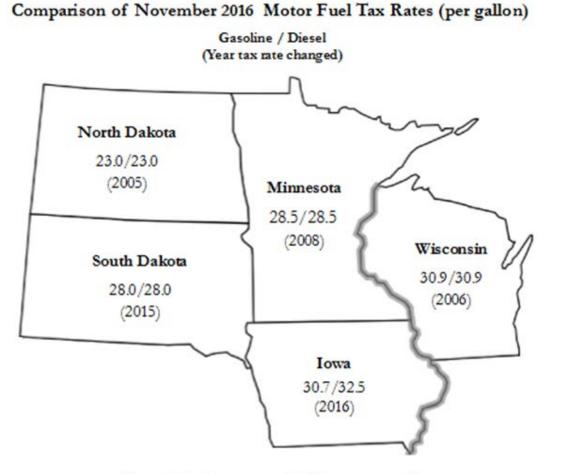

#### Gas Tax Rates



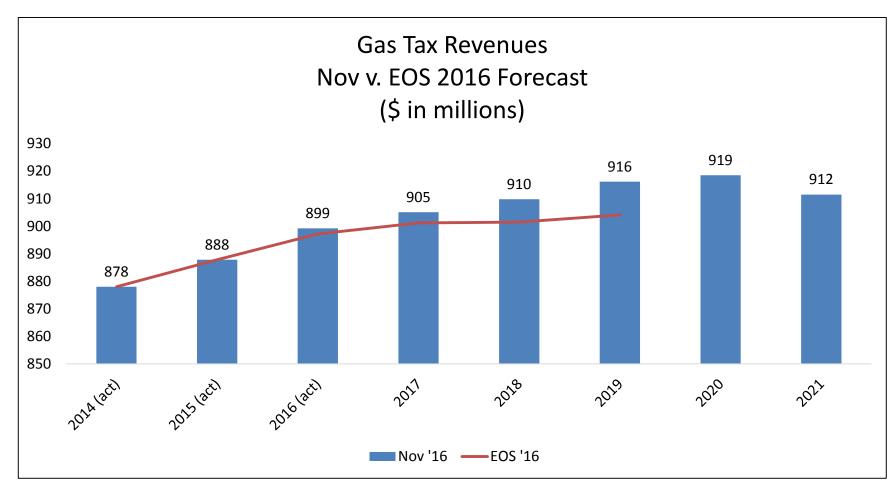

#### Gas Tax Forecast



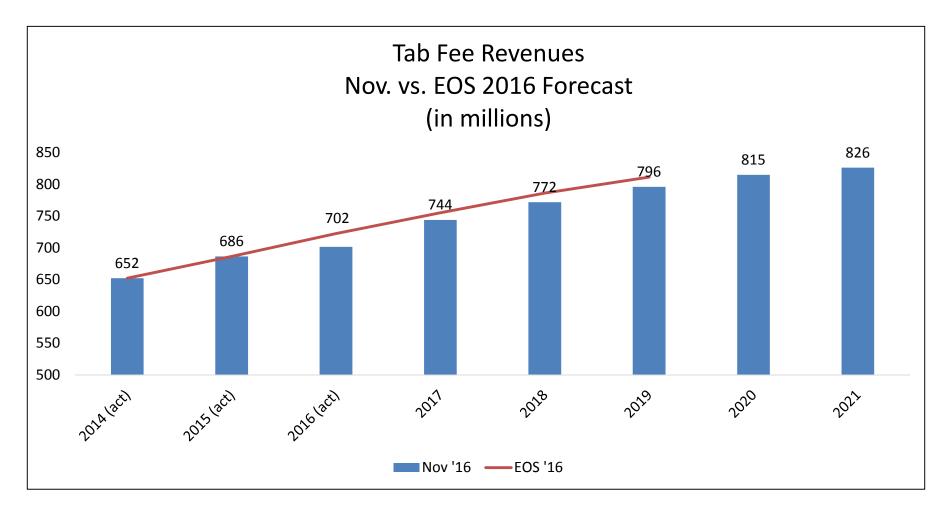

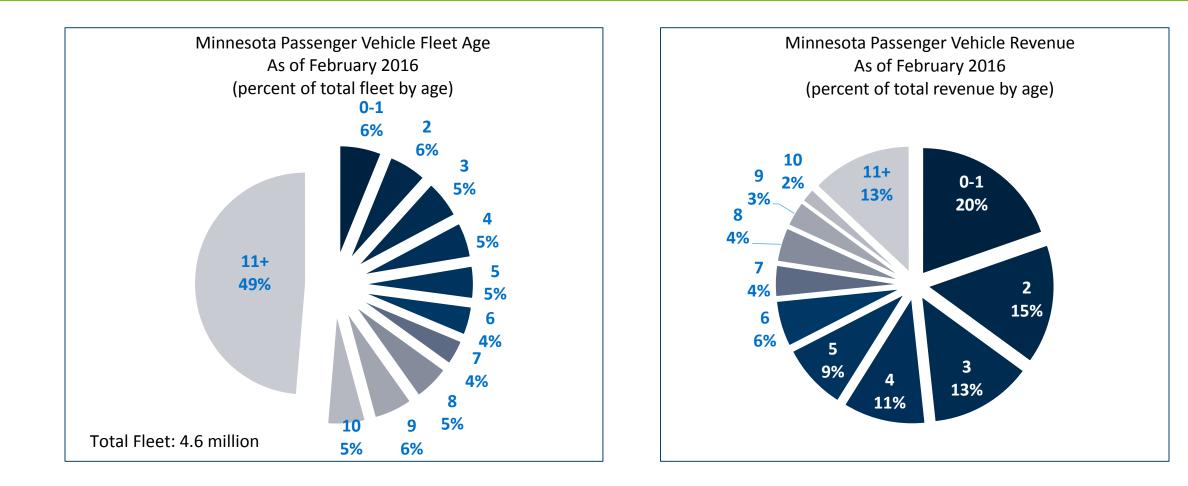

# Tab FeesMinnesota Passenger Vehicles



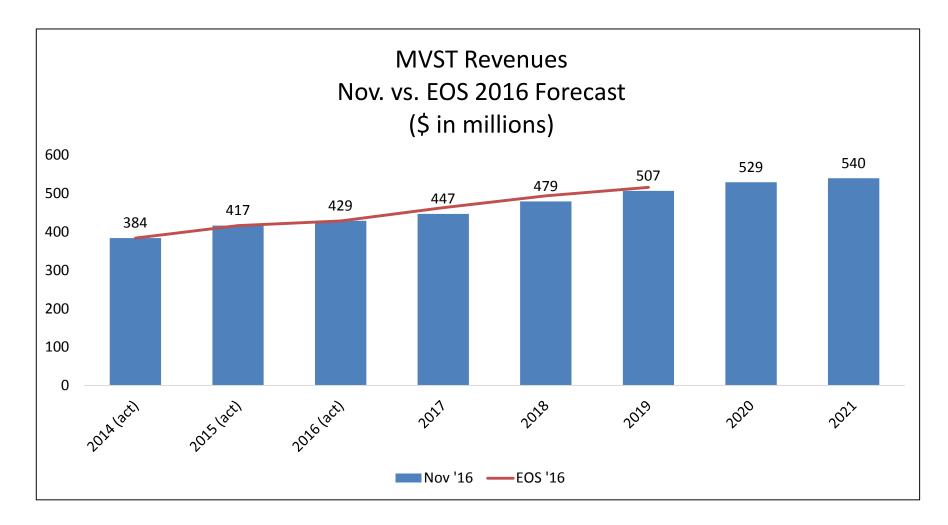

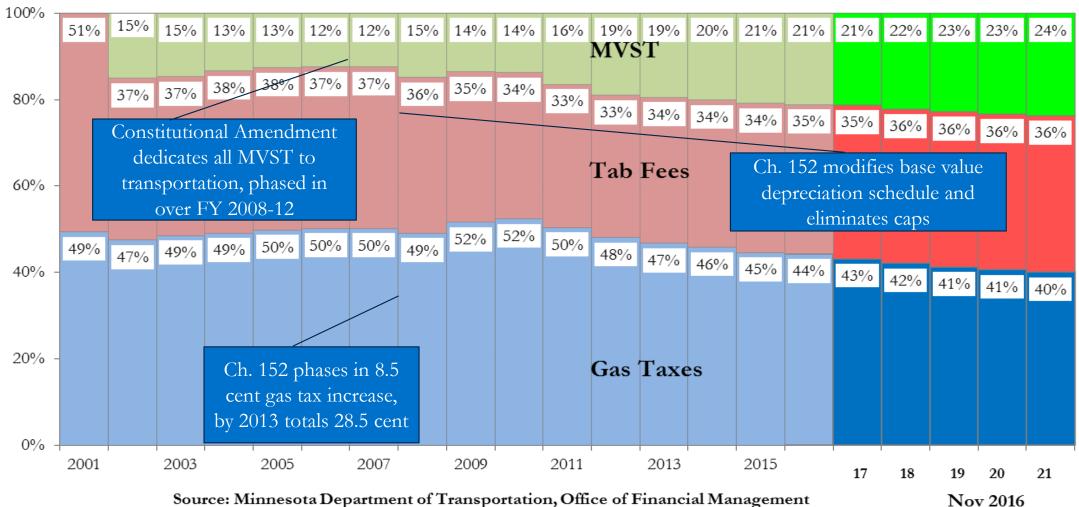

#### TH Fund Financial Policies Per Minnesota Statute 167.60

• Debt Management: Debt service for the Trunk Highway Fund should not exceed 20% of annual state revenues to the Trunk Highway Fund.

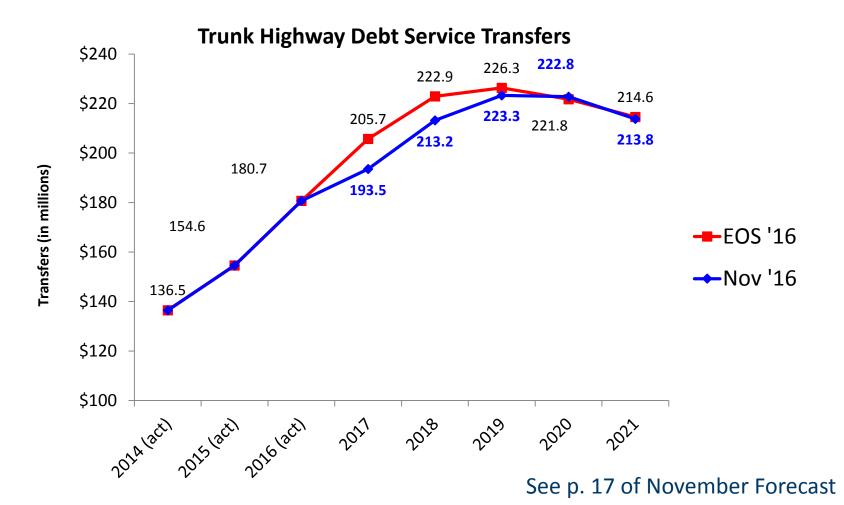
• Fund Balance: Maintain a balance of 6% of annual state revenues in the Trunk Highway Fund + 2% of authorized but unissued debt.

• Cash Balance: Maintain 15 days of cash flow needs.

• Advance Construction: Should not exceed target amounts in policy statement.

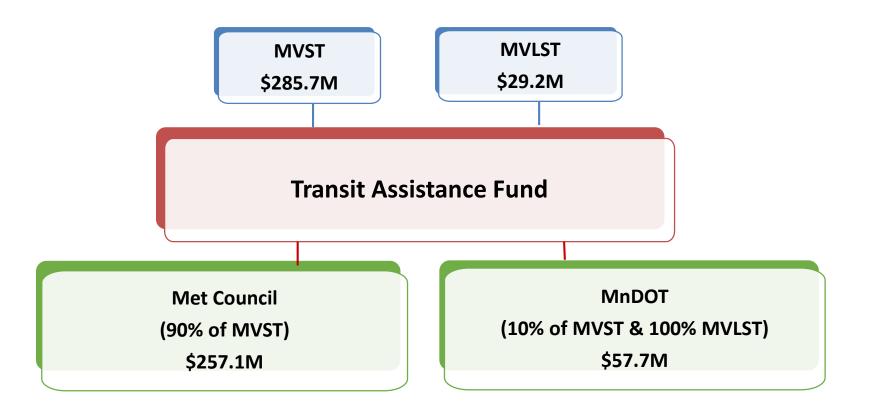

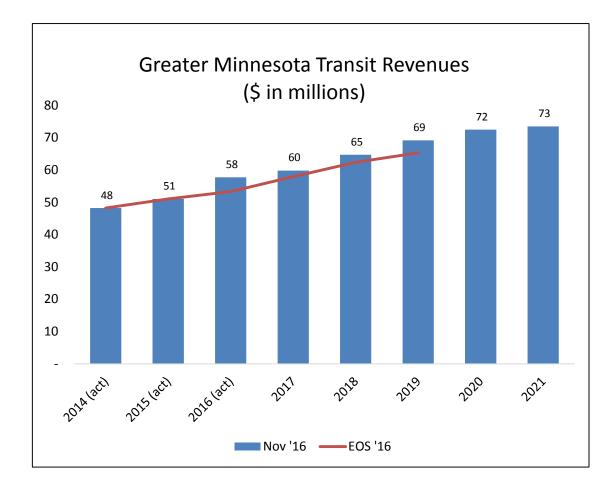

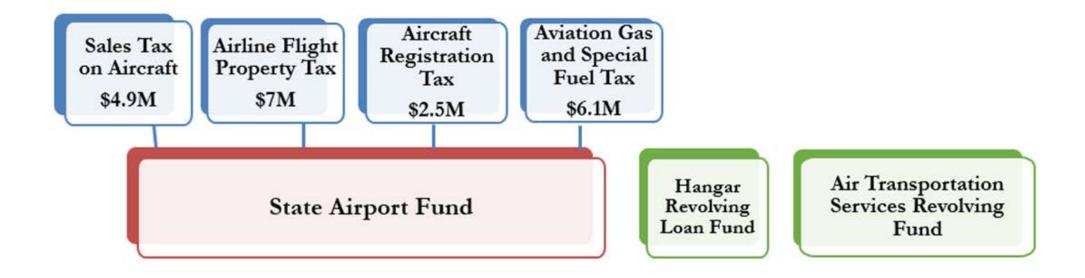

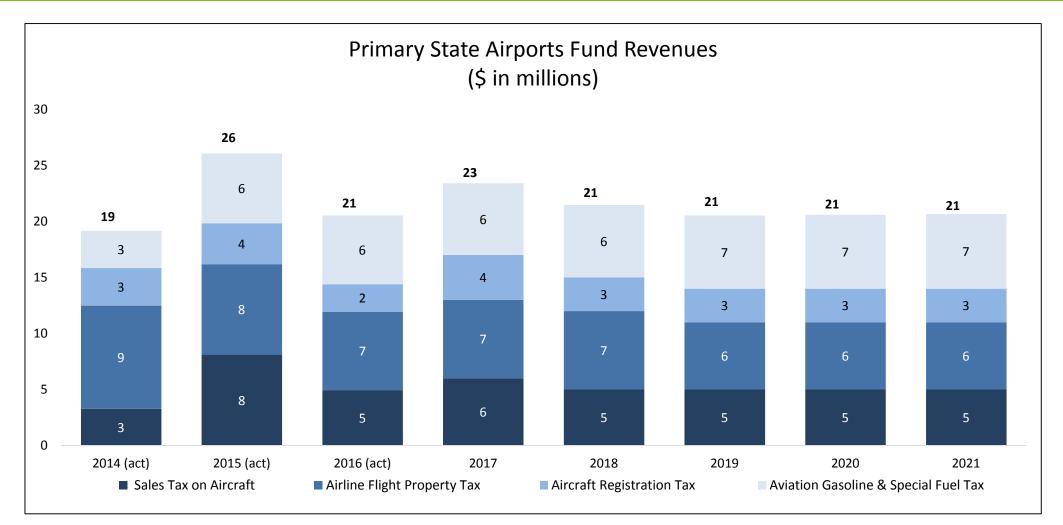
