It reflects non-partisan staff's recodification of 256B.04, subdivision 21, with no substantive changes.
Streamlining Medicaid Provider Enrollment/Nonpartisan staff recodification	7	[256B.0442]	This section establishes a new section of statute related to provider enrollment suspensions and terminations. It reflects non-partisan staff's recodification of 256B.04, subdivision 21, with no substantive changes, EXCEPT for a clarification in subdivision 4 that the DHS may terminate the enrollment of a provider if they have not submitted any claims in the previous 12 consecutive calendar months.

Streamlining Medicaid Provider Enrollment/Nonpartisan staff recodification	9	[256B.0444]	This section establishes a new section of statute related to additional provider enrollment requirements for durable medical equipment providers and other license types. It reflects non-partisan staff's recodification of 256B.04, subdivision 21, with no substantive changes.
MA for Employed Persons with Disabilities (MA-EPD) Good Cause Policy	10	Section 256B.057, subdivision 9	Clarifies that good cause for nonpayment cannot be granted for an MA-EPD premium that the enrollee has already paid.
Physician Oversight in Clinics	11	Section 256B.0625, subdivision 4	Conforms outpatient clinic requirements to federal law that, requiring that services are provided under the direction of a licensed physician.
