

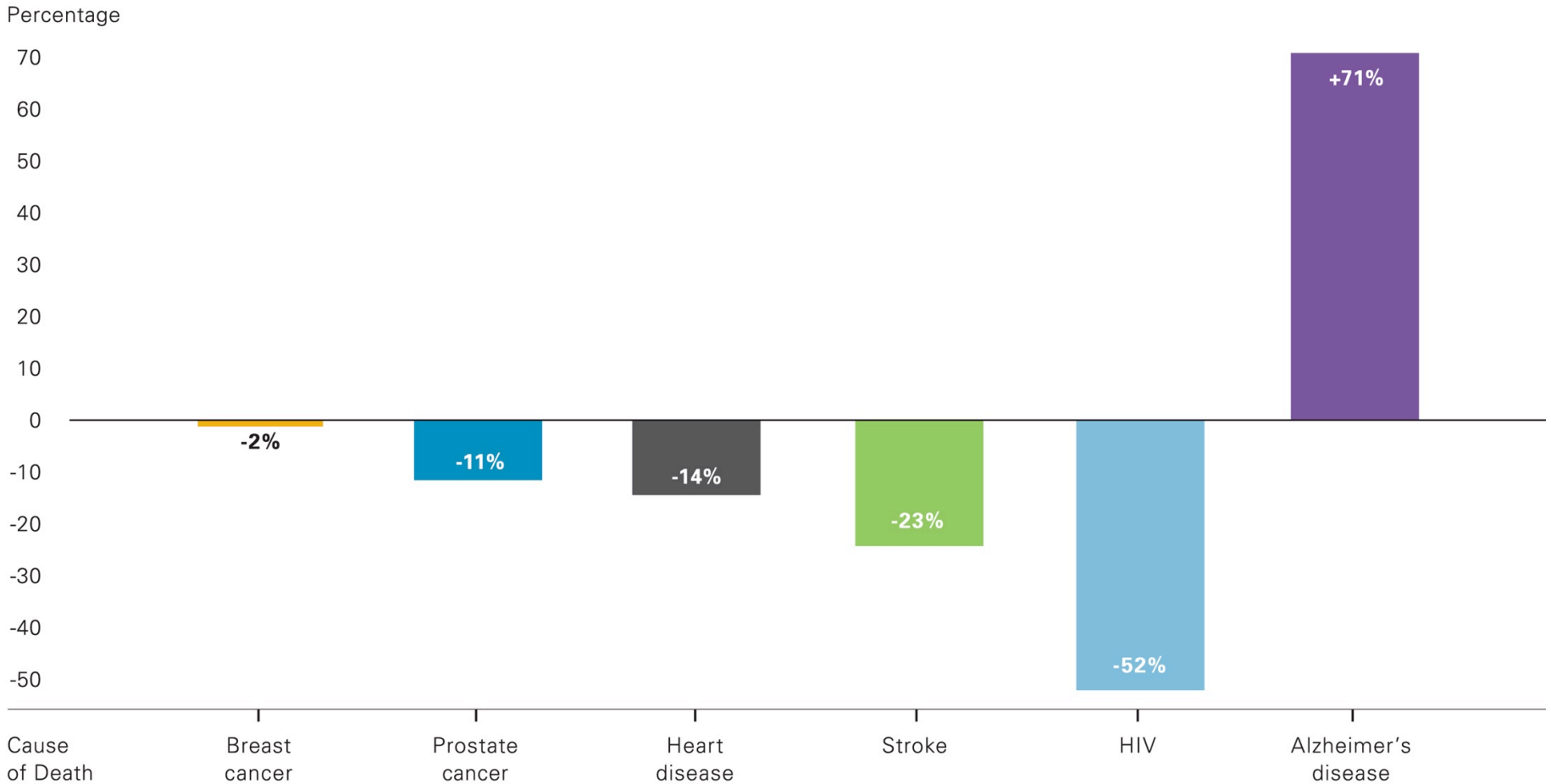

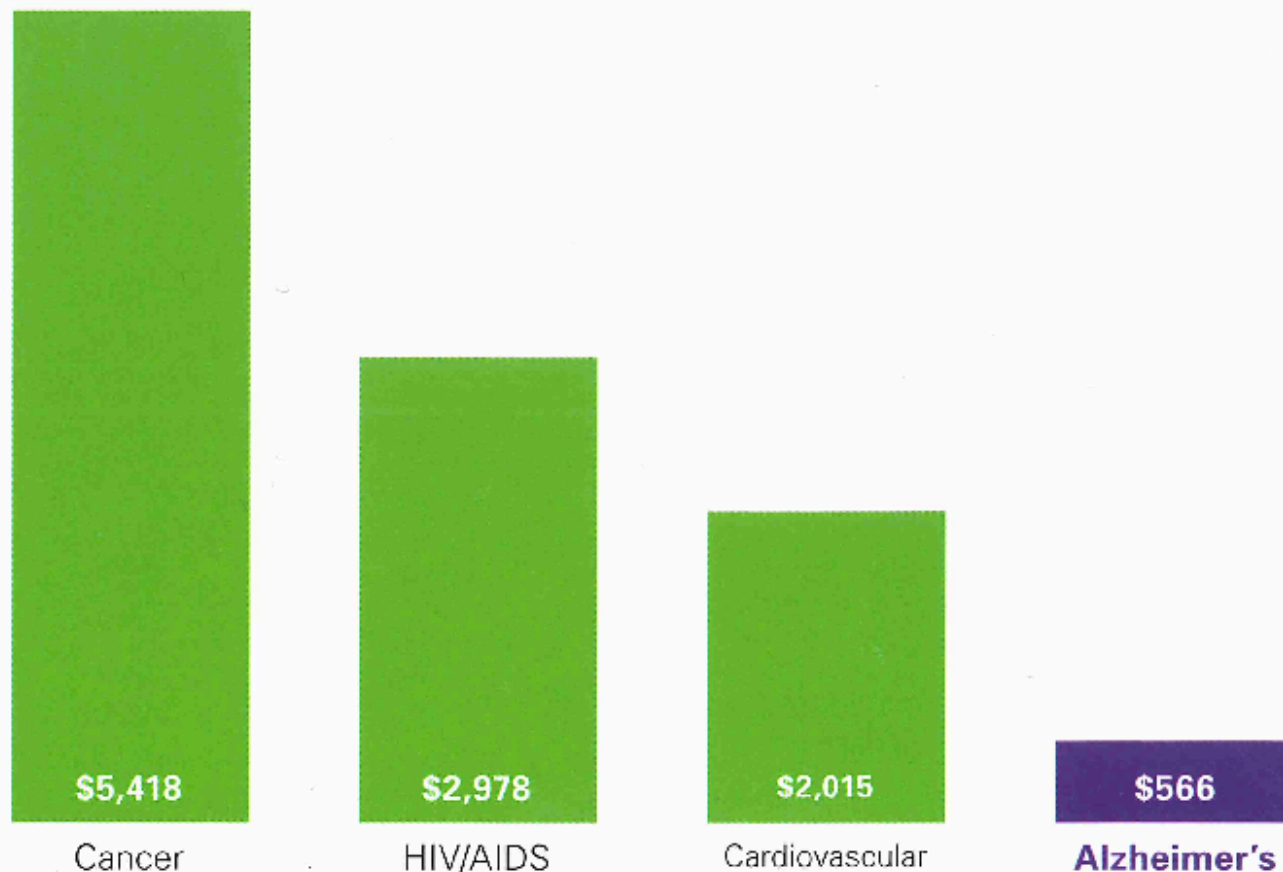

NIH research investments in other conditions, shown below, are paying off. This proven approach should be applied to Alzheimer's.

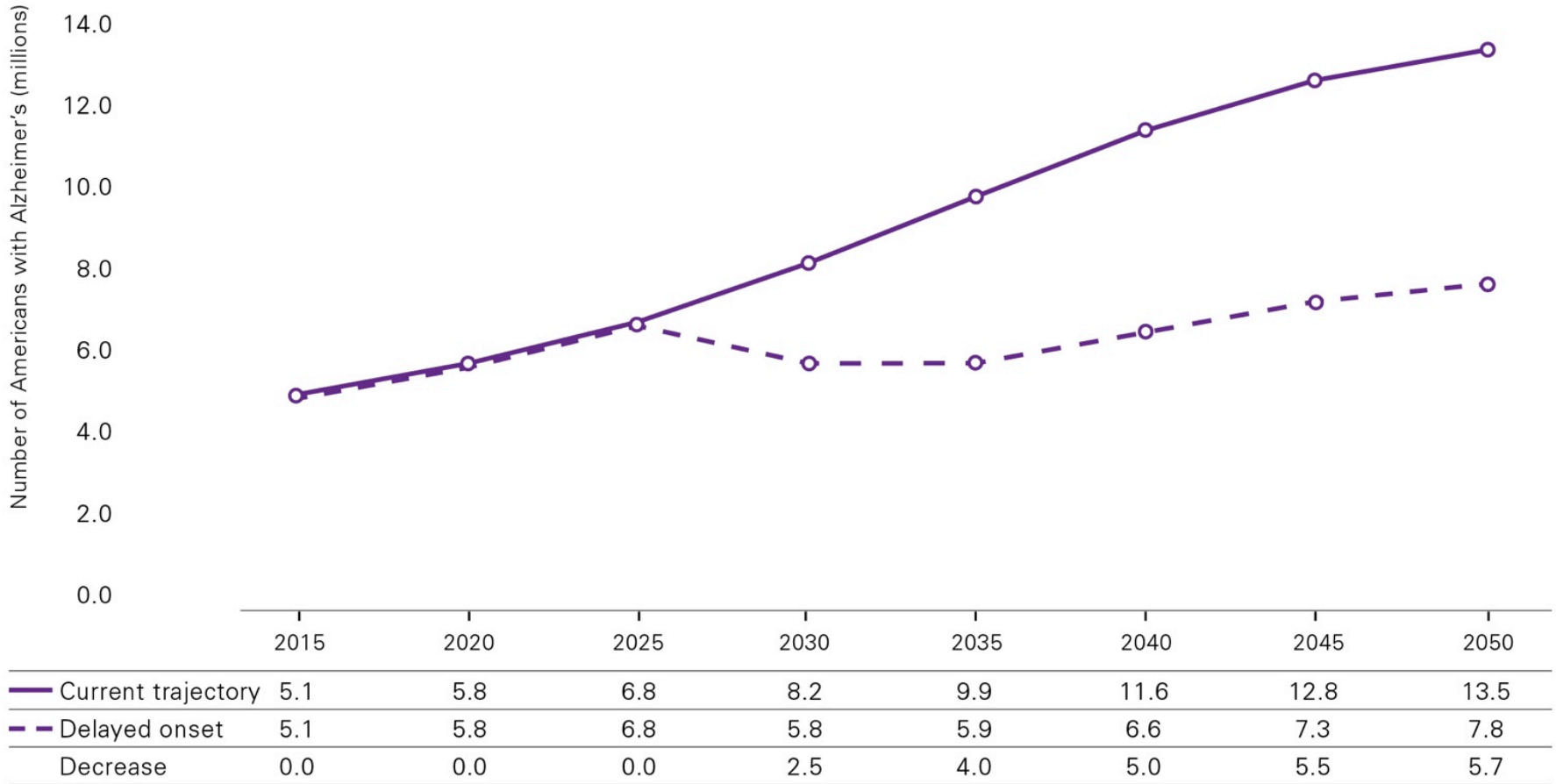
NIH Estimated Research Funding for FY2014.

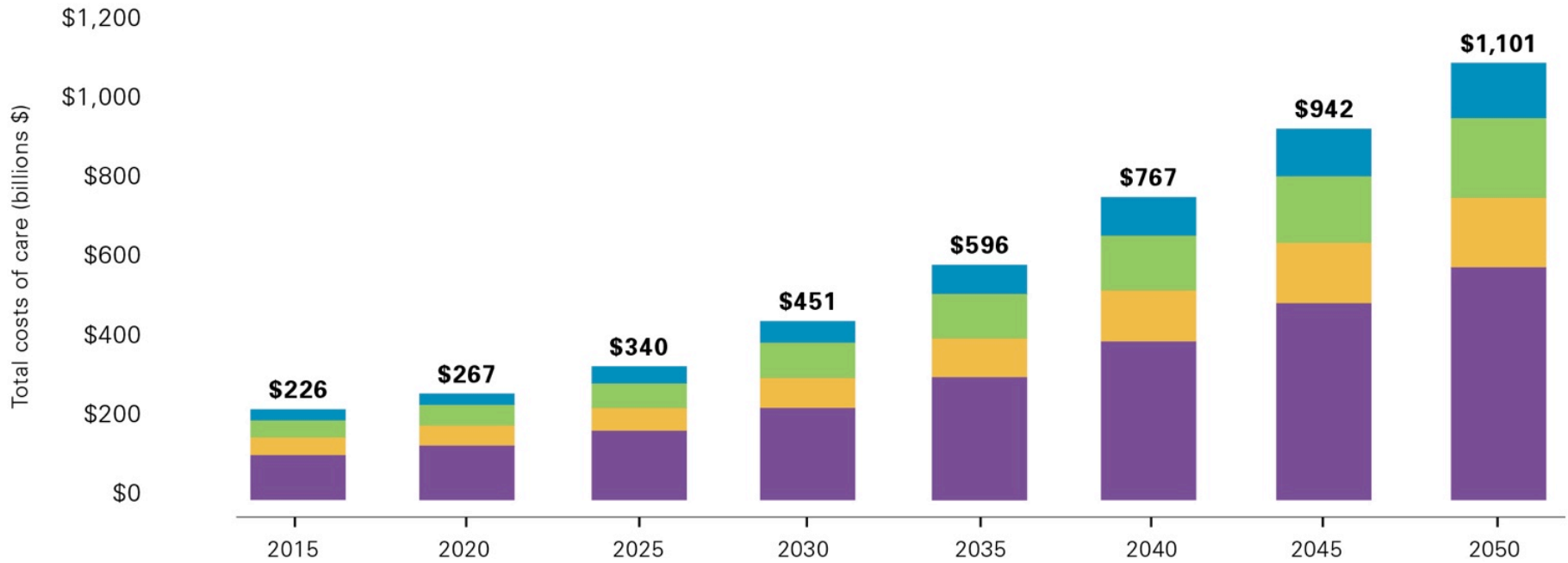
Impact of a Treatment That Delays Onset by Five Years on the Number of Americans Age 65 and Older Living with Alzheimer’s Disease, 2015-2050
