

1.1 Liebling and Scott from the Committee on Judiciary Finance and Civil Law to which
1.2 was referred:

1.3 H. F. No. 3782, A bill for an act relating to public safety; requiring disclosure of chemical
1.4 irritants used in certain buildings; requiring the commissioner of public safety to develop
1.5 a standard form; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 626.

1.6 Reported the same back with the following amendments:

1.7 Page 1, line 13, delete "who" and insert "from a law enforcement agency that" and after
1.8 "building" insert ", or an officer from the lead law enforcement agency if officers from
1.9 multiple agencies deploy chemical irritants,"

1.10 Page 2, line 8, after "deployed" insert "by a peace officer employed by the law
1.11 enforcement agency or local government unit"

1.12 Page 2, after line 8, insert:

1.13 "(e) If officers from multiple law enforcement agencies deployed chemical irritants,
1.14 smoke screens, or diversionary devices, the lead law enforcement agency must identify the
1.15 other law enforcement agencies involved when responding to a request described in paragraph
1.16 (c)."

1.17 With the recommendation that when so amended the bill be placed on the General
1.18 Register.
