

## Sanitary Sewer Needs

- Problem: Multiple rain events result in dumping raw sewage in the lakes.
- Addressing Inflow and Infiltration protects the environment and citizens, including the communities upstream of Lake Pepin.
- Stops Pollution – Keeps Waseca's lakes clean > keeps regional watersheds clean > keeps cropland clean > keeps our food supply safe.
- Protects Homes & Businesses – Prevents flooding & basement sewage backups. Reduces insurance claims.
- City of Waseca has appropriated monies for this project. Federal CDS has been sought as well.



## RAW SEWAGE PUMPING LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT WASECA.

Over 37 Million Gallons of Raw Sewage have been dumped into the environment in the last decade by the City of Waseca. We need your **partnership** to provide clean water to bolster job retention and creation, tourism, environmental duty, and regional growth.

\$8.9 Million – To repair pipes & manholes before economic and environmental disasters get worse. High-Risk Areas: Hospital district, residential neighborhoods, lakes.
