- HF448(Schwartz) Lafayette; water treatment plant improvements funding provided, bonds issued, and money appropriated.
- HF674(McDonald) South Haven; water and sewer infrastructure and street reconstruction improvements funding provided, bonds issued, and money appropriated.
- HF811(Wiener) West Unions; sewer infrastructure and street reconstruction improvements funding provided, bonds issued, and money appropriated.
