1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 62A.59, is amended to read:

1.4 **62A.59 COVERAGE OF SERVICE; PRIOR AUTHORIZATION.**

1.5 Subdivision 1. **Service for which prior authorization not required.** A health carrier  
1.6 issuing a health plan must not retrospectively deny or limit coverage of a health care service  
1.7 for which prior authorization was not required by the health carrier, unless there is evidence  
1.8 that the health care service was provided based on fraud or misinformation.

1.9 Subd. 2. **Service for which prior authorization required but not obtained.** A health  
1.10 carrier issuing a health plan must not deny or limit coverage of a health care service which  
1.11 the enrollee has already received solely on the basis of lack of prior authorization if the  
1.12 service would otherwise have been covered had the prior authorization been obtained.

1.13 Subd. 3. **Algorithm and artificial intelligence use prohibited.** A health carrier issuing  
1.14 a health plan is prohibited from using an algorithm or artificial intelligence when making  
1.15 an adverse determination to deny a prior authorization request.

1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2027, and applies to health  
1.17 plans offered, issued, or renewed on or after that date."
