If the 1.8 obligor is unable to file a motion contesting the May 1, 2020, cost-of-living adjustment 1.9 before June 30, 2020, due to circumstances related to the COVID-19 pandemic, but files 1.10 such a motion before October 31, 2020, the court may, in its discretion, order a full or partial 1.11 adjustment to the child support obligation, or decline to order an adjustment to the child 1.12 support obligation. Any full or partial adjustment shall be effective on May 1, 2020, unless 1.13 1.14 the court selects an alternative effective date based on the circumstances of the case. If the effective date creates an overpayment of support, the overpayment shall be reconciled 1.15 pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 518A.52." 1.16
