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A bill for an act

relating to elections; providing term limits for governor and lieutenant governor;
proposing an amendment to the Minnesota Constitution, article V, section 2.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSED.**

An amendment to the Minnesota Constitution is proposed to the people. If the amendment
is adopted, article V, section 2, will read:

Sec. 2. The term of office for the governor and lieutenant governor is four years and
until a successor is chosen and qualified. Each shall have attained the age of 25 years and,
shall have been a bona fide resident of the state for one year next preceding his election,
and shall be a citizen of the United States. A person must not be elected more than twice to
the office of governor, nor more than twice to the office of lieutenant governor.

Sec. 2. **SUBMISSION TO VOTERS.**

(a) The proposed amendment must be submitted to the people at the 2026 general election.

The question submitted must be:

"Shall the Minnesota Constitution be amended to place a limit of two terms on the offices
of governor and lieutenant governor beginning in 2030?"

2.4 Sec. 3. **APPLICABILITY.**

2.5 Elections prior to the 2030 general election must not be used for purposes of applying
2.6 the term limits imposed by the amendment in this act.
