3	Resolution on Administration of High School Page Program
4	
5	BE IT RESOLVED, by the Committee on Rules and Legislative Administration, that a High
6	School Page Program administered by the Sergeant-at-Arms must conform to the following
7	requirements: The maximum number of participants in the program during each year of the
8	biennial legislative session is $80 \underline{100}$. If there are no applicants for the program from a house
9	district, the Sergeant-at-Arms may, at the Sergeant's discretion, select another student. High
10	school pages serve for a period of one week and receive a stipend of \$10.00 per day. High
11	school pages who move from their usual place of residence must be reimbursed for actual
12	lodging expenses in an amount not to exceed \$75.00 per day, except when a higher
13	reimbursement is required due to the unavailability of a roommate. The Sergeant-at-Arms shall
14	report to the House Budget and Accounting Office the names of all high school pages. The
15	House of Representatives assumes no responsibility for supervising high school pages outside of
16	normal working hours, and the Sergeant-at-Arms shall so inform local school authorities and the
17	parents or guardians of each high school page.
