

1.1 Masin from the Subcommittee on Local Government to which was referred:

1.2 H. F. No. 3060, A bill for an act relating to local government; prohibiting certain
1.3 contracts; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 471.

1.4 Reported the same back with the following amendments:

1.5 Page 1, after line 4, insert:

1.6 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 243.51, subdivision 3, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 3. **Temporary detention.** (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b), the
1.8 commissioner of corrections is authorized to contract with agencies and bureaus of the
1.9 United States and with the appropriate officials of any other state or county of this state for
1.10 the temporary detention of any person in custody pursuant to any process issued under the
1.11 authority of the United States, other states of the United States, or the district courts of this
1.12 state. The contract shall provide for reimbursement to the state of Minnesota for all costs
1.13 and expenses involved, and, to the extent possible, require payment to the Department of
1.14 Corrections of a per diem amount that is substantially equal to or greater than the per diem
1.15 for the cost of housing Minnesota inmates at the same facility. This per diem cost shall be
1.16 based on the assumption that the facility is at or near capacity. Funds received under the
1.17 contracts shall be deposited in the state treasury and are appropriated to the commissioner
1.18 of corrections for correctional purposes.

1.19 (b) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the commissioner may not enter into an
1.20 agreement with the federal government to provide facilities to receive a person into custody
1.21 when the basis for detention is a civil violation of federal immigration law. An agreement
1.22 prohibited under this section, whether entered into before or after the effective date of this
1.23 section, is void.

1.24 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."
