1.2 (A16-1062), as follows:

1.3 Page 51, delete lines 22 to 35

1.4 Page 52, delete lines 1 to 9 and insert:

1.5 "(c) A Minnesota teacher preparation program, a district Grow Your Own teacher
1.6 program, a nonconventional teacher preparation program under Minnesota Rules, part
1.7 8705.2300, or an alternative teacher preparation program under Minnesota Statutes,
1.8 section 122A.245, may apply to the commissioner of education for a grant in the form and
1.9 manner determined by the commissioner. The commissioner may award grants of up to
1.10 two years to the extent funds are available. The commissioner annually must award at least
1.11 50 percent of grant funds to nonconventional and alternative preparation programs, giving
1.12 priority to funding programs that: recruit, retain, graduate, and place teacher candidates
1.13 who reflect the demographic diversity of the students enrolled in the district where the
1.14 teacher candidate is placed and provide the teachers with well qualified mentor teachers; or
1.15 train and place teacher candidates in subject areas or regions of the state identified by the
1.16 commissioner as shortage areas under Minnesota Statutes, section 127A.05, subdivision 6.

1.17 (d) A grant recipient under this subdivision, annually by January 15, must prepare a
1.18 report for the education commissioner and the K-12 and higher education committees of
1.19 the legislature in the form and manner determined by the commissioner. At a minimum,
1.20 the report must detail grant expenditures for the previous year and summarize program
1.21 outcomes based on teacher preparation and performance data consistent with paragraph
1.22 (c) and Minnesota Statutes, section 122A.09, subdivision 4a, paragraph (b)."
