1.5 Subd. 2. **Careless driving.** (a) Any person who operates or halts any vehicle upon any
1.6 street or highway carelessly or heedlessly in disregard of the rights of others, or in a manner
1.7 that endangers or is likely to endanger any property or any person, including the driver or
1.8 passengers of the vehicle, is guilty of a misdemeanor.

1.9 (b) Any person who operates or halts a light rail transit vehicle carelessly or heedlessly
1.10 in disregard of the rights of others, or in a manner that endangers or is likely to endanger
1.11 any property or any person, including the operator or passengers on the light rail transit
1.12 vehicle, is guilty of a misdemeanor.

1.13 (c) Notwithstanding section 609.101, subdivision 4, the Judicial Council may not place
1.14 a violation of this subdivision that causes great bodily harm or death to another on the
1.15 uniform fine schedule.

1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2020, and applies to crimes
1.17 committed on or after that date.

1.19 Section 1 may be cited as "Brooklyn Larson's Law."
