# Latino Workers are Disproportionately affected by COVID-19

- Latinos have the highest labor force participation of any demographic group in the U.S., yet most Latinos have below average median incomes and low health insurance rates due to the type of sectors that employ them.
- Those who remain employed are overwhelmingly employed in front line services deemed "essential" including, agricultural workers, food manufacturing, healthcare workers, grocery store workers, etc.
- Most workers faced income reductions due to reduced hours and did not have access the luxuries of telework, physical distancing, or little labor protections and self-isolation.
- Latinos work in several sectors with a high labor supply, which has reinvigorated the economic activity of several communities due to the entrepreneurial spirit and the many contributions of immigrants.

# CLUES Response to COVID-19 Since March 2020

- **Bilingual Rapid Response Hotline** and online resource Center. Transitioned training classes virtually and provides in-person support by appointment or over-the-phone.
- Processed over \$2.5 million in direct assistance for housing stability and homeless/eviction prevention.
- Raised and **distributed over \$1 million in emergency relief** funds for families that didn't qualify for public support.
- Reached **67k individuals and distributed 507,087 pounds of emergency cultural food to 15k families** (fresh produce, frozen meats, and shelf stable foods, essential household and hygiene items).
- Supported over 6k families experiencing economic insecurity access to employment, applications for government emergency relief, support navigation, applications for SNAP, consumer protections, free tax filing, etc.

## CLUES BILL — HF 656

Our bill seeks a direct appropriation for CLUES to:

- Addresses employment and economic disparities in the metro area and Greater Minnesota.
- Expands culturally tailored education and job skills training to stimulate higher wages and youth programming to promote educational advancement and career pathways in high demand fields.
- It supports our ability to connect workforce readiness and customized employment services for unemployed or underemployed individuals who experience the greatest barriers to self-reliance.
- Funds will support short-term certifications and technical skills in high-demand fields, to stabilize income and employment.
