The Legal Services Advocacy Project (LSAP) writes in support of the A-2 amendment to HF 3104/HF 3074, that ensures funds appropriated for self-directed caregiver grants, administered by the Minnesota Board of Aging under Minnesota Statutes, section 256.975, subdivision 12, are timely distributed and provided to appropriate applicants. LSAP is the statewide division of Legal Aid that provides legislative advocacy on behalf of our clients and all low-income Minnesotans and all elder Minnesotans, and all Minnesotans with disabilities.

Legal Aid's Elder Law Project helps protect the rights of elder Minnesotans and facilitate their access to critical services. The amendment's provisions that require consultation with Area Agencies on Aging and other community caregiver stakeholders in administering self-directed caregiver grants and provide an equal opportunity for all family caregivers of older adults in the application process are worthy additions to this state.
