## **Summary**

#### **Section Description**

#### 1 Verification of age for admission to public school [§ 120A.20, subd. 4]

Aligns with federal guidance that a school district may not require a birth certificate to enroll in a public school. Allows for a number of different mechanisms for verifying student age.

### 2 Administration [§ 124D.165, subd. 3]

Adds an alternative deadline for meeting the development screening requirement for early learning scholarship recipients who receive the scholarship before turning three years old.

### 3 Early childhood program eligibility [§ 124D.165, subd. 4]

Extends the deadline by which early childhood programs must have three- or four-star Parent Aware ratings to accept early learning scholarships. The deadline is extended from July 1, 2020, to such time when 40 percent of programs eligible to receive a Parent Aware rating have received a rating.

Eliminates obsolete language.

## 4 Interagency early intervention committees [§ 125A.30]

Adds tribal health and human service agencies to Interagency Early Intervention Committees.
