1.2 Page 1, before line 7, insert

1.3 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 256B.093, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.4 Subd. 2. **Eligibility.** Persons eligible for traumatic brain injury administrative case
1.5 management and consultation must be eligible medical assistance recipients who have
1.6 traumatic or certain acquired brain injury, including a brain injury acquired by fetal alcohol
1.7 exposure, and are at risk of institutionalization."

1.8 Page 1, after line 14, insert:

1.9 "Sec. 2. **DIRECTION TO THE COMMISSIONER.**

1.10 The commissioner of human services shall seek to amend the brain injury waiver to
1.11 include, as eligible persons, individuals with a fetal alcohol spectrum disorder diagnosis
1.12 who are not being served under the developmental disability waiver."

1.13 Page 1, delete lines 20 and 21

1.14 Page 2, line 2, after "organization" insert "and, where available, a family home visiting
1.15 program"

1.16 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references

1.17 Amend the title as follows:

1.18 Page 1, delete lines 2 and 3 and insert "human services; directing the commissioner of
1.19 human services to seek an amendment to the brain injury waiver; modifying the definition
1.20 of traumatic brain injury for the state traumatic brain injury program; appropriating money
1.21 for programs related to reducing fetal alcohol syndrome and related effects;"

1.22 Page 1, line 4, delete "to reducing fetal alcohol syndrome and related effects;"
