1.3 "Sec. 16. [15E.65] INSPECTOR GENERAL COORDINATING COMMITTEE.

1.4 Subdivision 1. Establishment; purpose. The Inspector General Coordinating Committee
1.5 is established to coordinate and strengthen the work of executive branch agencies in
1.6 safeguarding public resources through effective and efficient program integrity, audit,
1.7 internal control, and related functions.

1.8 Subd. 2. Membership. The Inspector General Coordinating Committee consists of the
1.9 following members:

1.10 (1) the inspector general appointed under this chapter, who serves as chair;

1.11 (2) the commissioner, or the commissioner's designee, of each agency that has its own
1.12 inspector general whether by law or commissioner's order;

1.13 (3) the superintendent of the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension in the Department of
1.14 Public Safety, or the superintendent's designee;

1.15 (4) the commissioner of administration, or the commissioner's designee, representing
1.16 the Office of Grants Management in the Department of Administration; and

1.17 (5) the commissioner of management and budget, or the commissioner's designee,
1.18 representing the Internal Controls and Accountability Unit in the Department of Management
1.19 and Budget.

1.20 Subd. 3. Duties. The Inspector General Coordinating Committee must:

1.21 (1) meet monthly to share investigative data, trends, and other information to better
1.22 prevent, detect, and investigate fraud and misuse in agency programs;

2.1 (2) assist the inspector general in the development of data sharing methods, investigative
2.2 best practices, and program integrity review processes for agency programs; and

2.3 (3) assist agencies in securing specialized internal audit, investigation, or other necessary
2.4 skills and tools.

2.5 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2027."
