Bill Description

This bill amends Minnesota Statutes, section 245.814, Liability Insurance for Licensed Providers by providing adult and child family foster home additional insurance coverage for property damage. It expands the coverage to include the foster provider's property and increases the maximums compensation of this coverage for each occurrence.

Assumptions

Sections 1 and 2: If the bill becomes law, it will impact the coverage, rates and premiums required under Minnesota Statutes, section 245.814. Changes are assumed to be effective July 1, 2017.

Upon being effective, an immediate change to the policy language and declarations page will need to be made to the coverage obtained through the Minnesota Joint Underwriters Association, as coverage is extended to certain types of claims that were previously excluded and the property damage limit has been increased.

No systems changes or staff costs are required to implement this language.
