The check must consist of a criminal history check of the state criminal records repository and a national criminal history records check. The commissioner shall accept the signed informed consent for the national criminal history records check request, the fingerprints of the applicant, and the fees. The commissioner shall submit the signed informed consent, fingerprints, and Bureau of Criminal Apprehension and Federal Bureau of Investigation fees to the superintendent of the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension who is authorized to exchange the fingerprints with the Federal Bureau of Investigation to obtain the applicant's national criminal history record information. The superintendent will also retrieve Minnesota criminal history data and will provide the results of both checks to the commissioner for a determination whether the officer, director, or stakeholder is disqualified."
