1.5 Subd. 18. **Annual data submission.** (a) As determined by the commissioner, a provider  
1.6 of consumer support grants under section 256.476; nursing services and home health services  
1.7 under section 256B.0625, subdivision 6a; home care nursing services under section  
1.8 256B.0625, subdivision 7; personal care assistance services under section 256B.0625,  
1.9 subdivision 19a; day training and habilitation services for residents of intermediate care  
1.10 facilities for persons with developmental disabilities under section 256B.501; or community  
1.11 first services and supports under section 256B.85, shall submit data to the commissioner  
1.12 on the following:

1.13 (1) wages of workers;

1.14 (2) hours worked;

1.15 (3) benefits paid and accrued;

1.16 (4) staff retention rates;

1.17 (5) amount of overtime paid;

1.18 (6) amount of travel time paid;

1.19 (7) vacancy rates; and

1.20 (8) other related data requested by the commissioner.

1.21 (b) The commissioner may adjust reporting requirements for a self-employed worker.

1.22 (c) A provider shall submit the data annually on a date specified by the commissioner.

1.23 The commissioner shall give a provider at least 30 calendar days to submit the data. If a

2.1 provider fails to timely submit the requested data, medical assistance reimbursement may  
2.2 be delayed.

2.3 (d) The commissioner shall analyze data annually to assess workforce issues and service  
2.4 access. The commissioner shall release data in an aggregate form, and business cost data  
2.5 from individual providers shall not be released except as provided for in current law.
