The DECC stands to recoup an incredible 40% of its heating costs by replacing faulty joints with welded pipers and inserting shut off valves. This could save the DECC over a million dollars over 10 years.



"Because of these faulty pipe fittings, we are forced to run hot water through our enormous building continuously. Then in the summer, we have to air condition not just for summer heat, but also our interior heat, too. It's just plain wasteful currently."

A core value at the Duluth Entertainment Convention Center (DECC) is hospitality. However, many guests have felt less than welcome for years in our 2,200 seat Symphony Hall.

That's because of the seating. Currently, our accessible seating section is not large enough to accommodate the number of guests who need it. At one of our past Veterans' Day Ceremonies, older vets missed the event because we didn't have enough seats available for them. In addition, the older 1966 seats are too small for much of the population today, in length and width. We are looking for funding to increase our accessible seating section and also to change out the old seats to be larger and give bigger rows.



To further support accessibility, upgrades are needed and long overdue for many of our elevators and escalators throughout the facility.
