#### **Overview**

This bill establishes school nurse recruitment grants and school nurse scholarships, and allows school nurses to receive loan forgiveness through the health professional education loan forgiveness program

# **Summary**

# Section Description

1 School nurse recruitment grants.

**Subd. 1. Establishment.** Establishes school nurse recruitment grants.

**Subd. 2. District staff program.** Allows a district to apply for a grant to establish a school nurse training program in partnership with a postsecondary institution. Requires the program to allow district staff or volunteers with an opportunity to obtain credentials to work as a school nurse. Specifies allowed uses for grant funds.

**Subd. 3. Secondary school student program.** Allows a district to use grant funds to develop and offer courses that introduce students to health careers and encourage students to pursue careers in nursing. Specifies allowed uses for grant funds.

**Subd. 4. Clinical experience grant.** Allows a district to use grant funds to establish a partnership with a nursing education program that exposes nursing students to a career as a school nurse.

**Subd. 5. Application and report.** Requires the commissioner of education to administer the grant. Requires grant recipients to report to the commissioner, and the commissioner to publish a report on how the grant funds were used.

**Effective date:** This section is effective July 1, 2022.

## **Section Description**

## 2 School nurse scholarships.

**Subd. 1. Establishment.** Requires the commissioner of higher education to establish a scholarship for students who intend to work as a licensed school nurse in a school district.

**Subd. 2. Eligibility.** Establishes scholarship eligibility criteria, including intent to work as a school nurse in a Minnesota school district.

**Subd. 3. Administration.** Requires the commissioner to administer the scholarship program. Caps a scholarship at \$7,500 per year.

**Subd. 4. Reporting.** Requires the commissioner to report to the legislature on the scholarship awards, number of applicants and recipients, and other summary data identified as outcome indicators.

**Effective date:** This section is effective July 1, 2022.

3 Creation of account. [Health professional education loan forgiveness program]
Allows a nurse practicing in a school district or charter school to receive loan forgiveness through the health professional education loan forgiveness program.

#### 4 Appropriation.

Appropriates money for school nurse recruitment grants and school nurse scholarships.
