Bill Description

Subd. 1: Creates a definition of carjacking, based upon the definition of a robbery.

Subd. 2: Requires the submission of the following data elements (quarterly) to the Department of Public Safety for inclusion in the Annual Uniform Crime Report, published by the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension (BCA):

- 1) The number of carjacking attempts;
- 2) The number of carjackings;
- 3) The number of persons injured in each offense;
- 4) The number of persons killed in each offense; and
- 5) Weapons used in each offense, if any.

Assumptions

Bureau of Criminal Apprehension

“Carjacking” data is currently collected under different terminology. A carjacking is a robbery where the property stolen by force is a motor vehicle.

This data may be viewed on the Minnesota Crime Data Explorer (updated monthly) currently, but will need to be compiled in a different manner and reformatted to reflect the requirements of the bill.

This will take approximately 10 hours for a staff person to complete.

10 hours of modifications x rate of \$36.55 = \$365.50

The BCA will absorb this cost.

Minnesota State Patrol

If a carjacking were to occur on a trunk highway, the State Patrol would refer the investigation and reporting to the county or local agency that has jurisdiction in the particular area. This has been past practice and is in law (299D.03, Sub. 12: “Persons arrested for violations other than traffic violations shall be referred forthwith to the appropriate local law

enforcement agency for further investigation or disposition"). No fiscal impact.

Expenditure and/or Revenue Formula

BCA

10 hours of modifications x rate of \$36.55 = \$365.50

The BCA will absorb this cost.
