

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 2103 as follows:

1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. APPROPRIATION; DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE.

1.4 Subdivision 1. **Ammonia, hydrogen, and renewable energy certificate tracking**
1.5 **system.** (a) \$2,000,000 in fiscal year 2027 is appropriated from the renewable development
1.6 account in the special revenue fund under Minnesota Statutes, section 116C.779, subdivision
1.7 1, to the commissioner of commerce for a grant to CleanCounts for technology that enables
1.8 tradable ammonia, hydrogen, and renewable energy certificates.

1.9 (b) Beginning January 1, 2027, and through January 1, 2031, an entity that receives a
1.10 grant under this section must submit a report to the legislative auditor that details how the
1.11 grant money received has been spent.

1.12 (c) Beginning January 1, 2031, and through January 1, 2036, an entity that receives a
1.13 grant under this subdivision must report to the commissioners of commerce and agriculture
1.14 regarding the number of ammonia certificates issued in Minnesota as a result of the grant
1.15 money received.

1.16 (d) The commissioner of commerce may use up to \$10,000 each year for administering
1.17 the grant in this subdivision.

1.18 (e) The appropriation under this subdivision is onetime and is available until June 30,
1.19 2029.

1.20 Subd. 2. **Great Plains Institute.** \$500,000 in fiscal year 2027 is appropriated from the
1.21 renewable development account in the special revenue fund under Minnesota Statutes,
1.22 section 116C.779, subdivision 1, to the commissioner of commerce for a grant to the Great
1.23 Plains Institute for work related to identifying existing and future areas of the state that are
1.24 suitable for additional distributed ammonia production and that have nearby wind or other

2.1 curtailed power. The appropriation under this subdivision is onetime and is available until
2.2 June 30, 2029.

2.3 **Sec. 2. APPROPRIATION; DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.**

2.4 \$4,000,000 in fiscal year 2027 is appropriated from the renewable development account
2.5 in the special revenue fund under Minnesota Statutes, section 116C.779, subdivision 1, to
2.6 the commissioner of agriculture for a grant to TalusAg for the production and operation of
2.7 at least two green fertilizer production systems located in Minnesota. The appropriation
2.8 under this section is onetime and is available until June 30, 2029.

2.9 **Sec. 3. APPROPRIATION; UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA.**

2.10 \$1,500,000 in fiscal year 2027 is appropriated from the renewable development account
2.11 in the special revenue fund under Minnesota Statutes, section 116C.779, subdivision 1, to
2.12 the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota to lead research, development, outreach,
2.13 and demonstration of energy systems that use hydrogen and ammonia production from
2.14 renewable energy resources and other sources of clean energy. The appropriation under this
2.15 section is onetime and is available until June 30, 2029."

2.16 Amend the title accordingly
