### **Bill Description**

This bill would require the council to ensure that bus operators receive training on assisting persons with disabilities and mobility limitations to enter and leave the vehicle. The training must cover assistance in circumstances where regular access to or from the vehicle is unsafe due to snow, ice, or other obstructions. The bill also requires the council to consult with the Transportation Accessibility Advisory Committee on the training.

#### **Assumptions**

Currently, Metro Transit trains operators on the topics covered by this bill as part of the existing training curriculum, and no ncremental training or expenses are incurred.

The Council assumes that the consultation with the Transportation Accessibility Advisory Committee will result in advice that could be integrated into existing training budgets and schedules.
