

1.1 A bill for an act  
 1.2 relating to energy; requiring all investor-owned utilities to submit a photovoltaic  
 1.3 demand credit rider with the Public Utilities Commission.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **PHOTOVOLTAIC DEMAND CREDIT RIDER.**

1.6 By October 1, 2021, all investor-owned utilities that have not already done so must  
 1.7 submit to the Public Utilities Commission a photovoltaic demand credit rider that reimburses  
 1.8 all demand metered customers with solar photovoltaic systems greater than 40 kilowatts  
 1.9 alternating current for the demand charge overbilling that occurs. The utility may submit  
 1.10 to the commission multiple options for calculation of reimbursement for demand charge  
 1.11 overbilling. At least one submission must be based on use of a capacity value stack  
 1.12 methodology. A photovoltaic demand credit rider must not be approved by the commission  
 1.13 unless it allows stand alone photovoltaic systems and photovoltaic systems coupled with  
 1.14 storage. The commission must approve the photovoltaic demand credit rider by June 30,  
 1.15 2022.

1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
