
\$500,000 Request Exhibit 1 - Cloquet Line to Echo Trail
This 1.6 mile trail segment will join the Cloquet Line to the Echo Trail, both are currently open to ATVs. We are going to repurpose a bridge over the Range River that previously was on federal land south of Ely. The Forest Service has allowed us to hold on to that bridge to be used to cross the Range River.


## \$500,000 Request Exhibit 2 - Tower to Pfeiffer Lake

This 13 mile trail segment will connect the Taconite Trail to the Pfeiffer Lake Campground which will be the central meeting point for the Voyageur and Quad Cities trail links. We are in the process of acquiring a snowmobile bridge from the DNR to cross the Pike River. This also provides a connection to the west side of Lake Vermilion.

Engineering/Permitting/Wetlands: \$125,000


This 12.5 mile trail segment will connect the Taconite Trail to the Wolf Lake and Mud Creek roads and open up hundreds of acres of woods and lakes for access by ATVers. Much of this is St. Louis County land and former Commissioner and State Representative Tom Rukavina was a big supporter of this project.

Engineering/Permitting/Wetlands/Construction: \$110,000

## BEAVER RIVER BRIDGE PROJECT - \$1.2 MILLION
