

Subject Tourism Improvement District Charges

Summary

State law allows lodging businesses to petition their local government for a tourism improvement district, through which the local government imposes charges used to fund tourism promotion and related activities.

This bill would allow lodging businesses to collect tourism improvement district charges from purchasers and would exclude those charges, if separately stated on the bill or receipt, from the sales price for the purposes of sales taxes.

This bill would apply retroactively to sales and purchases made after June 30, 2025.
