### Funds Available Until December 2024

- Expenditures incurred on or after March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021
- \$2.833 billion in two equal payments, one year apart
- Obligated by December 31, 2024

## Eligible Uses – Pandemic Response & Recovery

#### Public Health Response

- Containing and mitigating COVID-19
- Mental health and substance abuse treatment

#### Addressing Negative Economic Impacts

- Delivering assistance to families
- Small business support

#### Serving the Hardest Hit

- Addressing health disparities
- · Addressing education disparities through tutoring, afterschool programs, mental health programming
- Housing & sheltering support

#### Premium Pay for Essential Workers

Select Infrastructure – water, sewer and broadband

## Eligible Use: Replace Lost Revenue

- Calculation of lost revenue
  - Actual CY2020 revenue vs counterfactual trend
  - Allows for calculation of trend growth
    - 4.1% Floor
- Funds to replace lost revenue can be used broadly to support to support government services

## Ineligible

- Offset a tax cut
  - State must demonstrate how they paid for the tax cuts from other sources, by:
    - Enacting policies to raise other sources of revenue
    - Cutting spending
    - Higher revenue due to economic growth
- Deposit in pension funds
- Bolstering rainy day reserves
- Debt service payments

### Reporting

- Periodic financial reporting
- Annual Recovery Plan Performance report
- Achieving project outcomes in an effective, efficient, and equitable manner
- Key performance indicators identified by recipient
- August 31, 2021 and annually thereafter
