 - (b) A program, program grantee, or direct appropriation grant recipient with an initial request for funds on or after July 1, 2014 2025, may be considered for receipt of public funds for the first two fiscal years only if a plan that demonstrates how the data collection and reporting requirements under subdivision section 116L.98, subdivisions 3 and 4 will be met has been submitted and approved by the commissioner.
